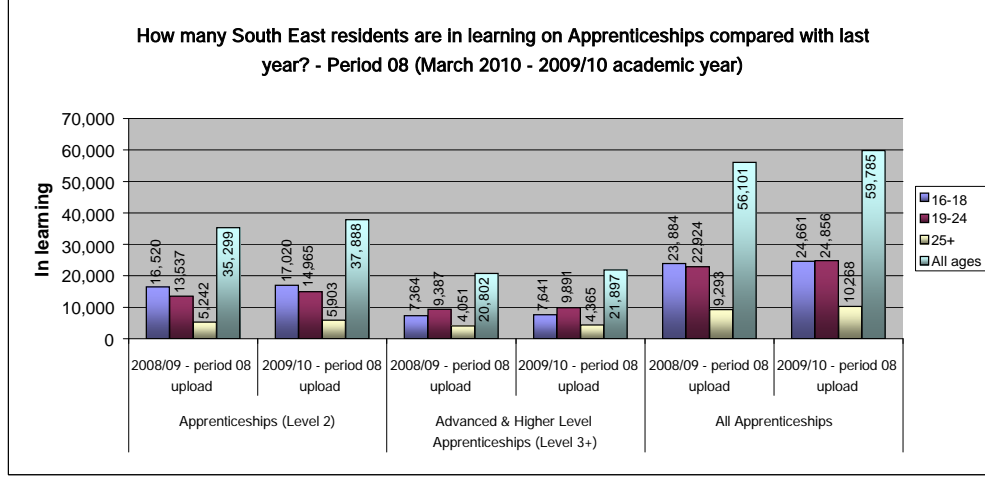
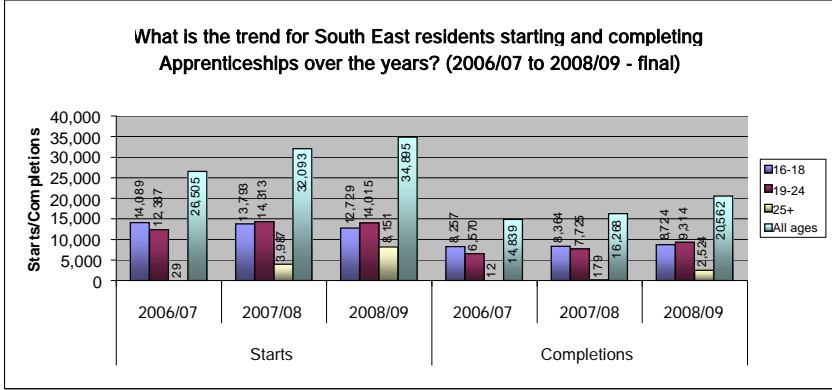
- The South East overall (level 2 & 3 combined) exceeds the National average Apprenticeship success rate across all age bands and all levels in 2008/09
- Level 2 Apprenticeships were 0.5%, 1.9% & 2.4% higher for 16-18, 19-24 & 25+ respectively in the South East than the National average.
- Level 3 Apprenticeships were 2.0%, 0.2% & 3.5% higher for 16-18, 19-24 & 25+ respectively in the South East than the National average.

NB Totals are year to date and are based on learners resident within the South East. There is no completions target for 09/10

- 16-18 starts are 11.3% (+1,088) higher at period 08 this year compared to the same upload period last year - this has greatly increased from 6.2% (+523) at period 07 showing the impact made from the recent AGE initiative

- 16-18 starts are at 89.7% of the profiled P08 starts target

- 19-24 starts are 20.7% higher at period 08 (1,991) compared to the same upload period last year



Starts for those aged 16-18 have fallen by 7.7% between 2007/08 (13,793) and 2008/09 (12,729 - final data).

There has also been a reduction in adults aged 19-24 starting an Apprenticeship, within the same period, down by 2.1%. There has been significant demand for 25+ Apprenticeships with a 104.4% (+4,164) increase in starts from 2007/08 (3,987) to 2008/09 (8,151)

The overall completion rate has increased year on year by 38.6% from 14,839 in 2006/07 to 20,562 in 2008/09

- There are 6.6% (+3,684) more South East resident learners in learning on Apprenticeships at period 08 in 2009/10 than the same period in 2008/09.

- 19-24 has risen by 8.4% (+1,932) & 25+ significantly by 10.5% (+975)

- 16-18 year olds in learning on all Apprenticeships has increased by 3.3% (+ 777) since the same period in 2008/09 (23,884 to 24,661)

- Regionally starts for 16-18 year olds are 11.3% (+1,088) higher at period 08 than the same period in 2008/09 with a significant impact made from the AGE initiative
- Portsmouth (+39.3% / +53), Southampton (+36.8% / +92) & Medway (+26.2% / +83) are showing the greatest increase for 16-18 starts for the same period last year - all in excess of a 25% increase.
- Milton Keynes (-10.0% / -35) and Brighton & Hove (-7.5% / -15) are the only Local Authorities with a decrease in 16-18 starts when comparing the same period in 2008/09
- Reflecting reduced budgets 25+ starts are down by 39.6% (-2,376).

- Completions uploaded at period 08 continue to be considerably higher than the same period last year with an overall increase of 30.1% (+3,011) from 9,998 at upload 08 in 2008/09 to 13,009 in 2009/10.
- 16-18 completions are up by 14.6% (692) a substantial increase from the +12.8% (+453) period 07 position. 19-24 completions have increased by 15.8% (+787)
- Completions for Adult Apprenticeships have increased significantly since the same period last year largely due to the increased demand on this still relatively new strand
