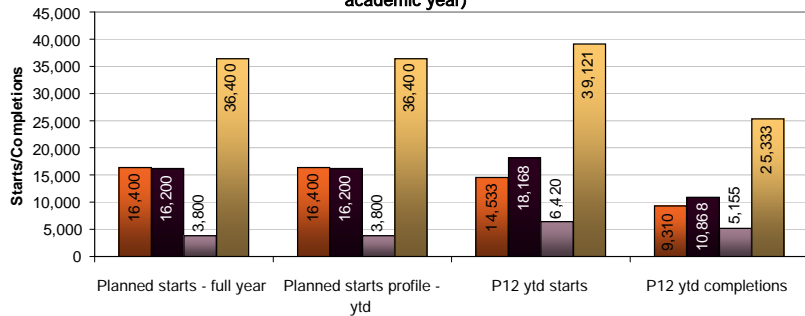
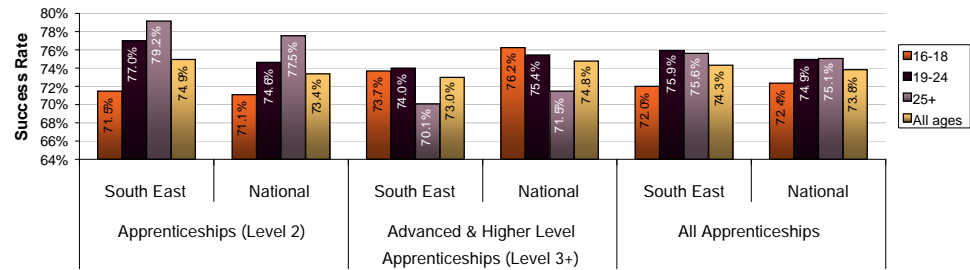


# South East and National Apprenticeship Service summary report - Full Year (July 2010 - 2009/10 academic year) - EXTERNAL

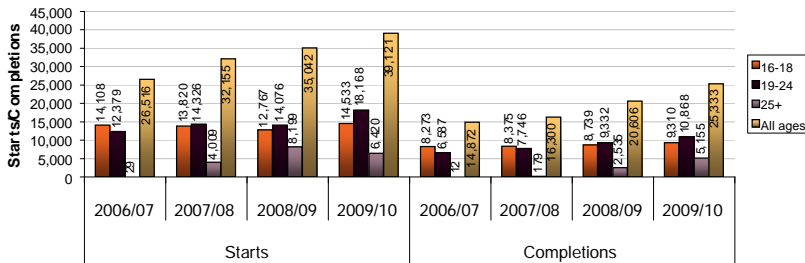

- 16-18 starts at 2009/10 year end were 13.8% / + 1,766 higher than 2008/09 with 88.6% of the full year starts target (16,400) achieved
- 19-24 starts at 2009/10 year end were 29.1% / + 4,092 higher than 2008/09 with the 16,200 greatly exceeded
- 25+ starts ended -21.7% / - 1,799 down on 2008/09 although the target of 3,800 was still greatly exceeded
- Overall the total starts target of 36,400 Apprenticeship starts has been exceeded by 2,721 starts or 107.5% was achieved

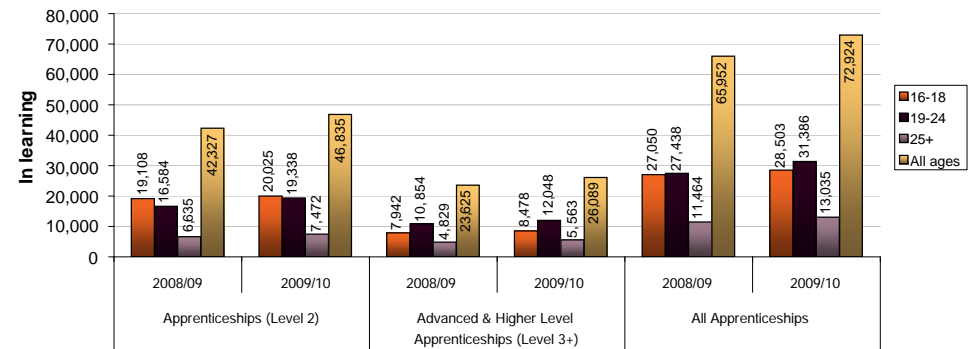
- Level 2 Apprenticeships are 0.4%, 2.4% & 1.6% higher for 16-18, 19-24 & 25+ respectively in the South East than the National average.
- Level 3 Apprenticeships are 2.6%, 1.4% & 1.4% lower for 16-18, 19-24 & 25+ respectively in the South East than the National average.

What is the trend for South East residents starting and completing Apprenticeships over the years? (2006/07 to 2009/10)



- Starts for those aged 16-18 have risen by 3.0% / + 425 between 2006/07 (14,108) and 2009/10 (14,533).
- Starts for those aged 19-24 have risen substantially by 46.8% / + 5,789 between 2006/07 (12,379) and 2009/10 18,168.
- 2009/10 is now full year

How many South East residents have been in learning on Apprenticeships compared with last year? - Full Year (July 2010 - 2009/10 academic year)



- There were 10.6% (+6,972) more South East resident learners' in learning on Apprenticeships in 2009/10 than 2008/09 with an all time high of 72,924 South East residents participating on any kind of Apprenticeship.
- 19-24 has risen by 14.4% (+3,948) & 25+ by 13.7% (+1,571)
- 16-18 year olds in learning on all Apprenticeships has increased by 5.4% (+1,453).
- This measure the total number of people who have been in learning at any time during the academic year - they may now have left

- Southampton (+50.2% / + 153), Portsmouth (-41.1% / - 79) & West Sussex (+23.2% / + 221) ended 2009/10 showing the greatest increase for 16-18 starts when compared to 2008/09.
- Wokingham (-3.8% / - 32) and West Berkshire (-2.6% / - 8) are the only Local Authorities that ended 2009/10 with a decrease in 16-18 starts when compared to 2008/09. Across all ages however they both showed an increase.
- 25+ starts are down by 21.7% (- 1,779) with all South East areas impacted. The Isle of Wight (-68.2% / - 152) & Portsmouth (-53.0% / - 116) showed the greatest decrease in 25+ starts when compared to 2008/09.
- Across all ages the Isle of Wight was the only Local Authority with a small decrease (-4.4% / -38) in Apprenticeship starts.

- Overall 25,333 people successfully completed an Apprenticeship at the end of 2009/10 which is 22.9% / +4,727 higher than 2008/09.
- 16-18 completions ended up by 6.5% (+ 571) at 9,310 successful completions. 19-24 completions increased by 16.5% (+1,536)
